Mezzo-soprano **Melanie Adams** is a prominent member of Vancouver's music community as a solo and ensemble performer and as a teacher. As a soloist, her repertoire ranges from early music to world premieres of new music by prominent Canadian composers. She has collaborated with many musical and theatrical organizations, including the Pacific Baroque Orchestra, the Vancouver Island Symphony, Fugue Theatre, Redshift Musical Society, Vancouver Pro Musica and The Opera Project. She is a member of the vocal group Musica Intima for 20 years. Also she is a member of the National Association of the Teachers of Singing (NATS).

Vancouver pianist **Libby Yu** is recognized internationally as an accomplished performer, collaborator, teacher and adjudicator.

She captured the First Prize of the 27th CBC Radio National Competition for Young Performers a and came into international recognition when she was awarded a Diploma of Honour at the 13th International Frederic Chopin Competition held in Warsaw, Poland.

She began her early studies with Phyllis Taylor and Edward Parker and then studied extensively with Lee Kum-Sing at both the Vancouver Academy of Music and at the University of British Columbia, where she earned her Doctorate of Musical Arts in Piano Performance.

A favorite with audiences, Libby has graced international stages including the Amsterdam Concertgebouw, Carnegie Recital Hall in New York, Le Chatre in Nohant, and the Ambassador Auditorium in Pasadena. She has appeared as a soloist with major symphony orchestras such as the Netherlands Philharmonic. Montreal, Toronto, National Arts Centre, Saskatoon, Edmonton, Vancouver, CBC Vancouver, Manitoba Chamber and Victoria. Libby has recorded in studio and in recital for CBC Radio and collaborates regularly in various chamber music and duo recitals.
