## **COVID** update

Considering the serious risk imposed by the current Covid-19 virus variant the BCCDC via the Provincial Health Officer has announced vaccination requirements in order for people to participate in certain types of activities. At DCMS the board is continuing with our Stage 4 Covid-19 Safety Plan procedures and protocols, and at this point are announcing that vaccinations will be required for faculty and students aged 12 years and over for all in-person lessons.

We understand that this may inconvenience some who wish to utilize the school for in-person lessons, however, our first priority is the health and safety of all participants going forward into the fall.

As of September 13, 2021, at least the first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine will be required for in-person lessons, and the second dose by October 24, 2021. We expect that these requirements, as well as Stage 4 of our Covid-19 Safety Plan, will remain in place until January 31, 2022.

We are monitoring the Covid-19 situation in the Province closely and should change be required prior to January 31, 2022, we will make those announcements in a timely fashion. Please contact our administrator for methods available to provide vaccination information to her office.
